Option 1. Performance Workshops

First of all, you need to select your main workshop. This is the workshop in which you will work towards an end product to perform at the end of the course. Please select TWO of the following workshops (of which you will be allocated one) in order or preference. Places in workshops are allocated on a first come first served basis. Although we will try to give everyone their first choice workshop, it may not always be possible.

Orchestra:

For all musicians who already play a string, brass or wind instrument (including sax). Pianists and **non musicians** are welcome to play percussion (provided).

Requirements:

Must own the instrument you wish to play (except for percussion which is provided).
Must have at least a basic knowledge of your instrument and very basic note reading skills.

Recommended for:

Musicians who play a classical instrument.
Musicians who used to play a classical instrument and wish to return.
Singers and Pianists who wish to play a percussion instrument.

Rockband:

A basic to intermediate rock outfit to perform classic rock songs suitable for electric guitarists, bassists, drummers, keyboards and singers

Requirements:

Must provide own guitar/bass/leads. Drum kits, amplifiers, keyboards, microphones are all provided.
Must have basic knowledge of the instrument you wish to play.

Recommended for:

Singers who wish to perform something a little more edgy.
All electric guitarists and bassists.
Those with an interest in keyboards and synthesizers
Those who already play drums (please note, there is a maximum of two drummers allocated in Rock Band on a first come, first served basis)

Folk Group:

An acoustic guitar and vocal group, ideal for those who love to strum and sing! Repertoire will be simple traditional folk or popular songs.

Requirements:

Guitarists must have existing ability (existing open chords to grade 1-2 standard) and own their own acoustic guitar. Steel or nylon string is fine.
Must be happy to sing (or mime!) along.

Recommended for:

Beginners to accomplished acoustic and classical guitars with parts to suit all abilities.

Voice Ensemble:

For those who do not play an instrument and/or just love to sing all day long! No experience necessary.

Recommended for:

Non musicians
Those who wish to develop their skills in voice
Those who wish to improve their musical and performance confidence

Option 2. Come and Try.

Finally, alongside your main workshop you have a chance to visit one of our come and try workshops. **There is no experience or any requirements** for any of these workshops and all equipment is provided. Please select TWO of following workshops (of which you will be allocated one) in order or preference. Places in workshops are allocated on a first come first served basis.
